



Liechtenstein Open International Amateur Championship 2023

Ladies & Men

September, 8th– 10th

The Principality of Liechtenstein is located in the border triangle of Switzerland, Austria and Germany. Therefore, we have decided to play the Liechtenstein Open Amateur Championship (men and ladies) around the borders of our small country Liechtenstein on three different courses over 54 holes. Under the motto "*3 Countries 1 Championship*" this tournament is a WAGR ranked event and certainly unique in the EGA tournament calendar because the winner has to fight his way through three countries!

Conditions The Championship is open to male and female amateur golfers as defined by the current Rules of Amateur Status. All competitors must be members of a golf club or a golf organization which itself is a member of its national federation / association.

Eligibility Entry is limited to 60 competitors (39 men and 21 ladies)
The handicap limit is 9,9 or better, certified by the respective handicap authority and must be validated on the date of entry.
If the number of entries exceeds 60, places in the starting field will be decided by the Handicap ballot. Accepted entries and reserve lists will be published on our website.
Exemptions:
The following will be exempt from the ballot provided they satisfy the handicap requirements: Six (6) players as nominated by the Liechtenstein Golf Association.



Ties

In case of a tie for 1st place, the winner shall be determined by sudden death play-off on at beforehand announced holes. For any further tie, the winners will be decided based on the final stipulated 36, 18, 9, 6, 3 holes or last hole, in that order.

Rules

The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf approved by R&A, the Liechtenstein Golf Association 'Hard Card', the General Conditions of Competition, with the Local Rules approved by the Championship Committee.

Registration

All entries have to be submitted online on the Liechtenstein Golf Association's website must register via the official website of the Liechtenstein Golf Association (www.golf.li/turniere).

Foreign players who are not yet registered on (PC Caddie) can register via following link (www.golf.li/turniere/liechtenstein-open/)

Liechtenstein Golf Association must receive fully completed entry form until **Friday, September 1st, 2023, no later than 6 p.m.** Entry Fees must be transferred before Wednesday, September 6th 2023.

A competitor who does not register up to this time and or did not pay the entry fee in time, is liable to be withdrawn from the championship.
